KCSO Arrests Wanted Person David T. Perry

On Monday, April 24, 2017, shortly after 6PM, deputies from the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office received an anonymous tip that wanted person David T. Perry, 34, of Post Falls, was currently at an address off S. Douglas Ct. near Post Falls.

Deputies were able to quickly establish a perimeter on the residence in question and Perry was taken into custody swiftly and without incident.

Perry was wanted on four different local warrants; a \$10,000 warrant for Grand Theft and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm; a \$10,000 warrant for Failure to Appear on a Pretrial Conference for Petit Theft charges; a \$50,000 warrant for Failure to Appear on a Hearing for 3 counts of Burglary and most notably a \$500,000 warrant for 65 counts of Grand Theft/Aiding and Abetting stemming from an extensive mail theft ring being investigated by KCSO over the past several months. Perry will most likely make first appearance in a Kootenai County courtroom tomorrow.

Perry had been the focus of several wanted persons bulletins over these warrants and the Sheriff's Office is very pleased to have him in custody.

KCSO would like to thank all of the people responsible for the various tips and leads that have been received in regard to Perry and remind others that tips related to wanted persons, crime reports and other suspicious activities can be reported anonymously by using the Anonymous Tip Form, which can be found under the "Contact" tab on the KCSO Website, www.kcsheriff.com.
