### New Information regarding Hit & Run that Injured a Bicyclist

**Hayden, ID** – The Kootenai County Sheriff's Office is seeking the public's assistance in locating what is likely a black Dodge Caliber SUV that fled the scene after striking and injuring a bicyclist on Prairie Ave. New information obtained last night indicates the vehicle had a windshield banner with "Los Angeles" in black and white letters across the upper portion of the windshield.

Based on evidence left at the scene, the vehicle sustained visible damage to the passenger's side front to area to include the head lamp and turn light assembly, mirror, and bumper. The vehicle was likely being operated by a balding male with a mustache. The suspect was last seen leaving the scene on W. Prairie Ave.
