KCSO TRAFFIC STOP LEADS TO HEROIN TRAFFICKING ARRESTS

Coeur d'Alene, ID – On January 25th, 2017 at approximately 11:56 PM, two Kootenai County Sheriff's Office Deputies conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle on Interstate 90 at milepost 17 near the City of Coeur d'Alene, ID.

Deputies contacted the driver, Alyza R. Hawk 23 of Pablo, MT and the passenger David A. Kallowat 32 of Pablo, MT. During the contact, deputies learned Hawk was driving on a suspended license. Deputies also discovered Kallowat had a felony warrant out of Polston, MT for possession of dangerous drugs and a probation violation warrant out of Bonneville County, ID.

Hawk was arrested for her suspended license and no proof of insurance. Illegal drugs were then located in her pockets. A search of the car resulted in deputies locating two ounces of heroin, hydrocodone, marijuana, paraphernalia, and a large amount of US currency. After being arrested for his warrants and the drugs in the car, additional heroin was located hidden in Kallowat's clothes while being booked in the jail.

Hawk was arrested for trafficking heroin, possession of hydrocodone, possession of marijuana, possession of paraphernalia, driving without privileges, and driving without proof of insurance. Kallowat was arrested for his warrants, trafficking heroin, possession of heroin, introducing contraband into a jail, and possession of paraphernalia.
