KCSO TRAFFIC STOP LEADS TO DRUG ARREST

Post Falls, ID – On January 14th, 2017 at approximately 04:57AM, two Kootenai County Sheriff's Office Deputies conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle near the intersection of W. Seltice Way. x N. Pleasant View Rd. in the City of Post Falls, ID. As the deputies approached the car, they observed the driver hiding drug paraphernalia.

Upon further investigation, methamphetamine packaged for sales was located.

The driver, Ashley M. Allen 25 of Spokane, was arrested for possession of methamphetamine with intent to deliver, possession of paraphernalia, concealing evidence, and introducing contraband into a jail after more drugs were located hidden on her person inside the jail. Allen has been booked into the Kootenai County Public Safety Building 18 previous times to include trafficking methamphetamine, probation violations, burglary, and theft.
