

ONLINE POLICE REPORTING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question: What do I do if online incident reporting is not right for me?

Answer: If your incident is an emergency, call 9-1-1. If non-emergency, call 208-446-1300.

Question: What if this happened in another city? Can I file a report using this online police citizen reporting system?

Answer: No. If a crime took place outside the jurisdiction of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, please call the police department for that city.

Question: What if I filed a lost property report but later find that item? How do I cancel my original report?

Answer: What until the original report has been assigned a case #. Then you must go back on Coplogic and file a supplemental report using the assigned case #, indicating the item has been found.

Question: What is a known suspect?

Answer: A known suspect is when you or someone else knows the person(s) or where to find the person(s) who committed the crime or the license plate number of the vehicle the suspect(s) were in or any information that will lead us to the suspect(s).
