Post Falls Driver Licensing Office Opening Delayed

Post Falls, ID – The re-opening of the Kootenai County Driver Licensing Office has been delayed until late August, due to vendor logistical issues.

Early this week, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office was advised by the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD), that the re-opening of the Kootenai County Drivers Licensing Office in Post Falls will be delayed due to logistical issues. Due to these unforeseen issues, ITD Officials indicated that computers, cameras, testing stations and other required state equipment to be installed prior to opening have been delayed.

Representatives from ITD are still working on this project, but stated the anticipated opening date will now be closer to end of August. The Kootenai County Sheriff's Office will continue to provide updates, to include an actually opening date, as the project continues to progress and more information becomes available.

The Kootenai County Drivers Licensing Office, located at 451 Government Way in Coeur d'Alene will continue to service Drivers Licensing needs Monday – Friday 7:30am-5:30pm.
