

KOOTENAI COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT
RESERVE DEPUTY REQUIREMENTS

Successful applicants will be required to attend 248 hours of training in the North Idaho Reserve Officer Academy. The classes begin in January of each calendar year, and are usually held as follows: (The academy will begin the first week of January)

Tuesday evenings	4 hours
Thursday evenings	4 hours
Saturday	8 hours
Sunday	Some will be scheduled

There is optional training available. Classes will be held over a 12 week period, weekday evenings, Saturdays and some Sundays.

Must successfully pass the P.O.S.T. Reserve Academy test and shall meet the height and weight standards to their stature. A POST physical examination and polygraph will be required, at the Sheriff's Department expense. Kootenai County requires successfully completing the POST physical agility prior to the beginning of the academy.

Applicants who successfully complete the above requirements will then be sworn in as a Reserve Deputy Sheriff. A 40 hour (minimum) Kootenai County Sheriff's Department in-service training to follow the Reserve Academy prior to Reserve Deputy being able to 'ride' with a Deputy Sheriff.

ATTENTION TO ALL APPLICANTS:

1. Each Reserve Deputy is required to provide a monthly minimum of twenty (20) hours of volunteer law enforcement time to the Department. In addition, attendance at a monthly Reserve meeting is required.
2. There is **NO PAY COMPENSATION** for the position of Reserve Deputy Sheriff.
3. Reserves must supply their own firearm, holster and magazine holder. The Sheriff's Department will supply other uniform items, to include a ballistic vest, as available. Information on the style, type and quantity of gear will be supplied to the Reserve at a later date.

PROVIDED TO THE RESERVE BY THE KCSD

1. Any applicable training
2. P.O.S.T. medical and physical examination
3. Reserve Deputy badge
4. Required uniform, as supply exists.
5. Workers Compensation and State Industrial (Only during Reserve duty time.)
6. Insurance for false arrest.
