KCSO LOCATES OCCUPIED STOLEN CAR AND MAKES ARREST

Post Falls, ID – On April 29th, 2017 at approximately 3:40 PM, a Kootenai County Sheriff Deputy located an occupied stolen car behind the Flying J truck stop on 5th Ave. in Post Falls, ID.

The sole occupant of the car was detained without incident and identified as Aleksandra A. Bukovskaya, 29 of Washington. During a search of the stolen vehicle, large amounts of reported stolen mail, reported stolen and possible fraudulent checks, reported stolen credit cards, and reported stolen driver's licenses were located. Burglary tools to include window punches and numerous keys for other vehicles, prescriptions drugs, marijuana, and methamphetamine were also located.

Bukovskaya was arrested for possession of a stolen vehicle, possession of a stolen Financial Transaction Card, possession of stolen property, possession of burglary tools, possession of methamphetamine, possession of schedule III drug, possession of marijuana, and possession of paraphernalia.

The stolen items were linked to vehicle thefts in Spokane City, Spokane Valley, Deer Park, and Coeur d'Alene. The case is still active and being worked by both the Spokane County Sheriff's Office and the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office.
