### KCSO Deputies Arrest Suspect with 30 Previous Arrests

**Hayden, Idaho:** On November 13, 2017 Kootenai County deputies arrested Timie G. Lenz – 57. Lenz was arrested for Obstructing, Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Destruction of Evidence.

Deputies encountered Lenz after responding to the 2000 block of W. Prairie Ave. as they were attempting to arrest Lisa M. Helvie -48 for an outstanding drug warrant. While trying to locate Helvie deputies encountered Lenz, who is alleged to have obstructed them, which resulted in his arrest.

After Lenz's arrest, deputies discovered Lenz has 30 previous arrests in Kootenai County and has been charged with nearly 40 previous misdemeanor and felony crimes since 1999 to include; Possession of Controlled Substances, Aggravated Battery, Open Container, Driving without Privileges, Theft, Possession of Stolen Property, Providing False Info to Police, Probation Violations, Harassing Telephone calls, DUI, Possession of Paraphernalia, and Fail to Provide insurance.

Helvie has been previously been charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance, Petit Theft, and Driving without Privileges. Lenz and Helvie were booked into the Kootenai County Jail and are awaiting their first appearances.
