Media Release Escapee Sought – Crime Stoppers Reward Offered April 26, 2017

Kootenai County, Idaho: The Kootenai County Sheriff's Office and the Yakima County Corrections Center are asking for your help in locating escapee **Steven Douglas Roche**. A reward for information leading to his arrest is now being offered through crime stoppers.

On 04/04/2017 Steven D. Roche and Chad E. Tipton escaped from the Yakima County Correctional Center, where they were being held for the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office. Tipton was re-captured on 04/08/2017, but Roche is still at large.

Roche is 31 years old, 6' tall, 320lbs with red hair and blue eyes. Roche is from the Spokane and North Idaho area and has a lengthy criminal history in both jurisdictions.

Crime Stoppers of the Inland Northwest is offering a cash reward for anyone providing information leading to an arrest in this incident.
